

In order to use your Thunderbird Mail app with your Windstream Hosted Email, please follow the steps in this guide.


Step 1: New Account

Open Thunderbird and, under Create a new account, choose Email.




Step 2: Use Existing

Step 5: Server Settings


Enter the server information for both incoming and outgoing servers. Use the information in the table below.
